

User information with regard to the PSI Spring 2004 release (Intended for GBV, DDB, Hebis, BSZ)

The PSI Spring 2004 release is a 'minor' release and involves some enhancements requested by customers. This document summarises all enhancements contained in the new release.

OCLC PICA explored the full-text search possibilities within the PSI software. Full-text indexes of the Consumentenbond database were integrated with PSI as a pilot project. This is the first move in developing full-text searching. It is expected that users in the future will search full-text content instead of only metadata.

Lately we were facing some problems with updating large off-line databases in the Netherlands. These problems are solved now by installing a 64-bit version. Production problems in PiCarta as a result of the large amount of mutations in the Dutch CBS system will now occur less frequently.

The Admin module is available for university libraries and the Dutch national library in the Netherlands. In this module customers can make changes in the configuration table. The Admin module consists of several components that all have their own added value:

- **OPAC linking**
By means of a URL template customers can link to several OPAC systems on a record basis. Changes can be made in the full name, the URL, the default language, and the supporting language for the OPAC link.
- **Open URL linking**
Customers themselves can generate the Open URL link. The base URL and the attributes can be changed. In addition, customers can change preferences such as pictures and screen names.
- **Channel administration**
Customers themselves can view their channel administration. IP addresses, databases and times are presented on the screen.
- **Auto login**
The auto login screen shows user/password combinations for certain IP addresses. Only the IP ranges related to the user are presented. Customers can adjust the presented records. Moreover it is possible to search in these login records.

The PSI Spring 2004 release also contains adjustments to support SRU version 1.1. These adjustments are currently available only on the test environment. The intention is that these adjustments will be made available on the production environment in the future. More and more customers will implement SRU as it is one of the worldwide accepted search protocols. By

supporting SRU within PSI, the PSI software is up to date and OCLC PICA is able to deliver optimal support to the customers.
